# Why a project on MIL

Today the abundance of media content gives us increased opportunities to find **information**, but also **disinformation**, **misinformation**...

In parallel: increase of polarization, hate speech, radicalization and extremism happening both offline and online

This "discourse of fear", challenges human rights and disrupts human solidarity

# Why MIL?

Everybody could be consumer and producer of information, misinformation and disinformation...

Media can directly or indirectly challenge or give validation to polarized rhetoric

→ Media and Information Literacy among the most effective responses to polarization and division

## What is MIL?

- MIL: combination of competencies (knowledge, skills and attitudes) each citizen should possess in order to navigate a knowledge society.
- MIL empowers citizens to:
  - Understand the functions of media and other information providers
  - Critically evaluate their content
  - Make informed decisions as users and producers of information and media content

The Youth Empowerment project works to advance Media and Information Literacy (MIL) as a holistic response to foster safe and ethic **use, consumption** and **production** of media and internet among youth in Jordan.

18 month project (July 2018-December 2019)

The Project aims at deconstructing stereotypes and promoting mutual understanding among youth in Jordan, trough three main components:

- Public schools
- Local radio stations
- Civil society organizations

 $\rightarrow$  in line with 2019-2020 Gov priorities

### Local Radio Stations

**Specific objective 3:** Professors and students in Irbid and Ma'an produce and broadcast on-air MIL content that prevents hate speech

#### Output

3.1) 8 editors in chief (professors and students) and 50 students at Yarmouk and Al Hussein Bin Talal Universities radio stations are trained on MIL skills;

3.2) At least 30 pilot radio shows are developed by professors and students and broadcast by Yarmouk FM and Sawt Al Janoub radios and other radio stations.


#### Local Radio Stations

- Carry out 3-day-training workshops on MIL for at least 4 editors in chief (professors and students) in Yarmouk University and 4 in Al Hussein Bin Talal University
- Carry out 2-day-training workshops on MIL for at least 50 students, including volunteers of the Yarmouk FM and Sawt Al Janoub radio stations
